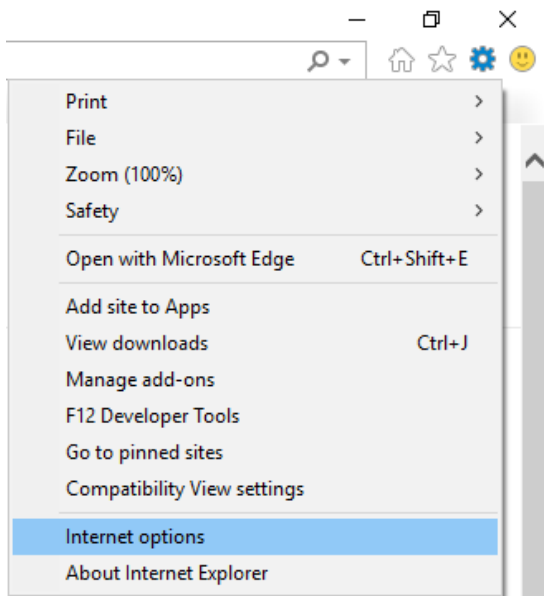

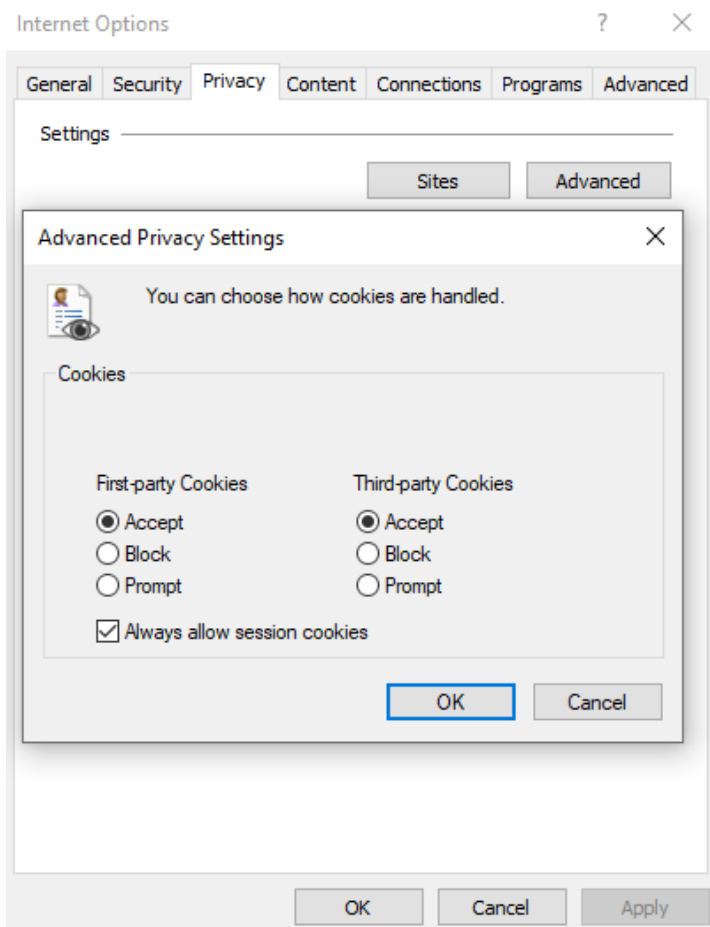

Internet Explorer 11

Press the gear-icon on the upper right corner and select 'Internet options':

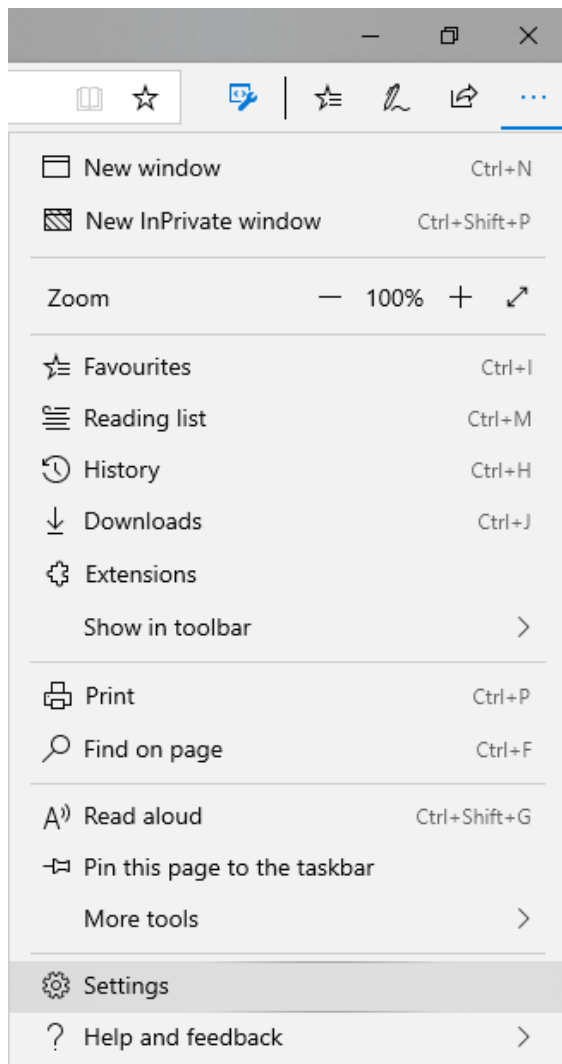


Go to the privacy tab, select 'Advanced' and accept first- and third-party cookies:

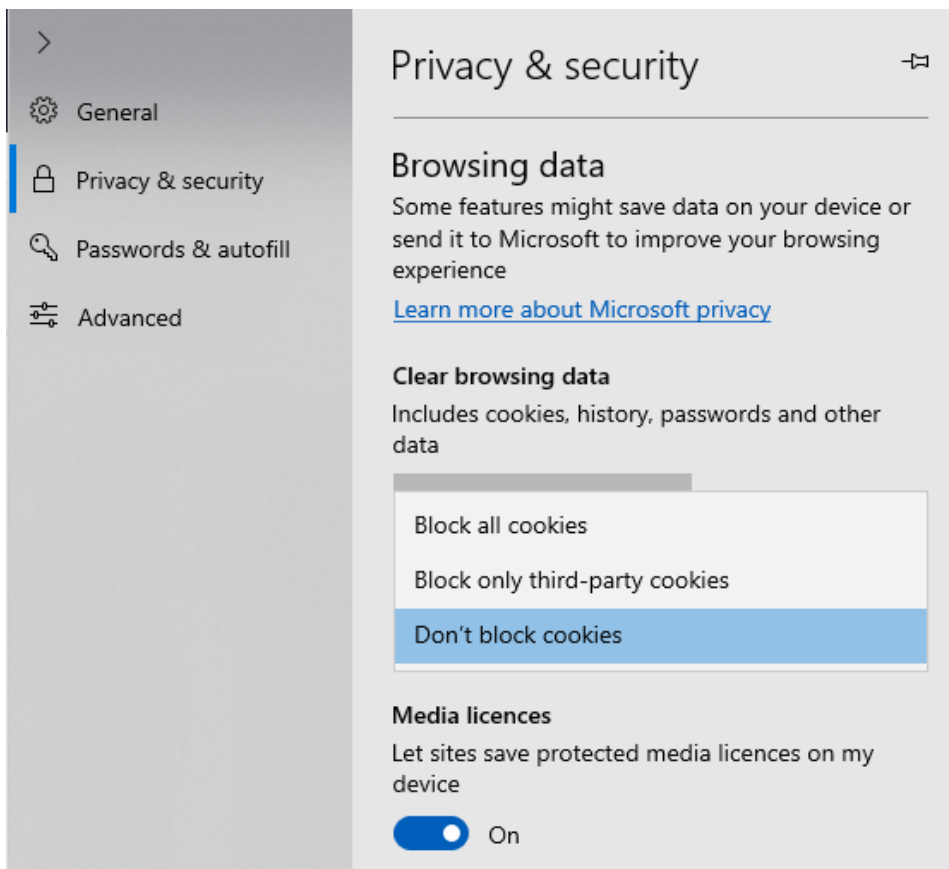
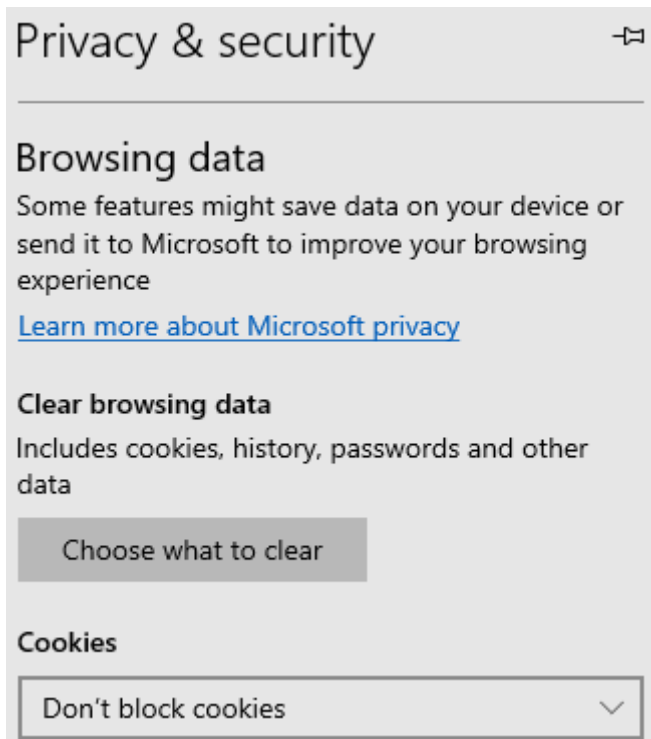


Edge

Press the 3-dots in the upper right corner and select 'Settings':

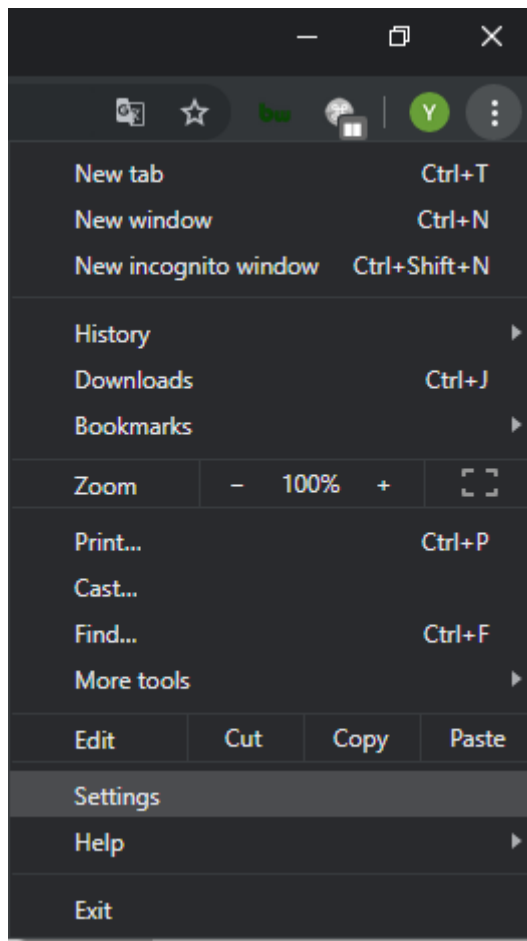


On the left-side select “Privacy & security” and change the ‘Cookies’ dropdown to “Don’t block cookies”:

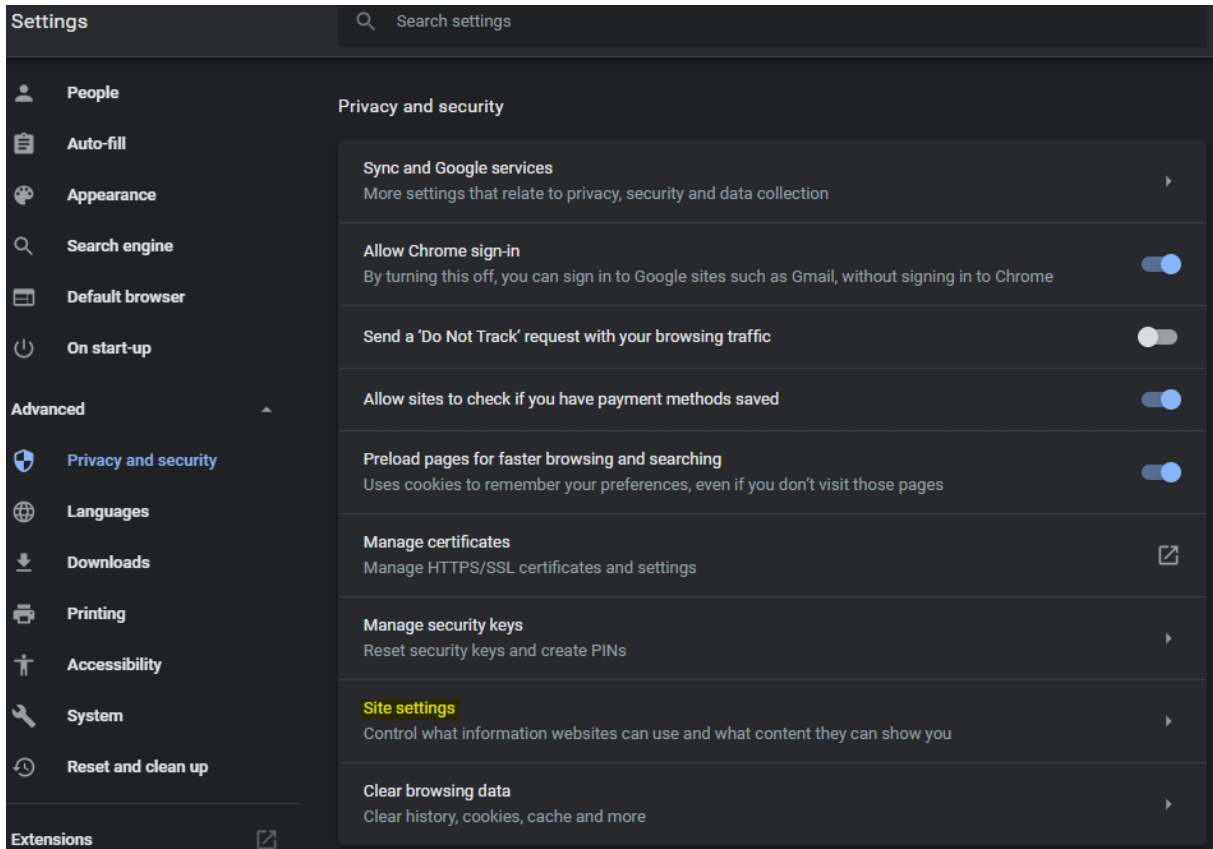


Chrome

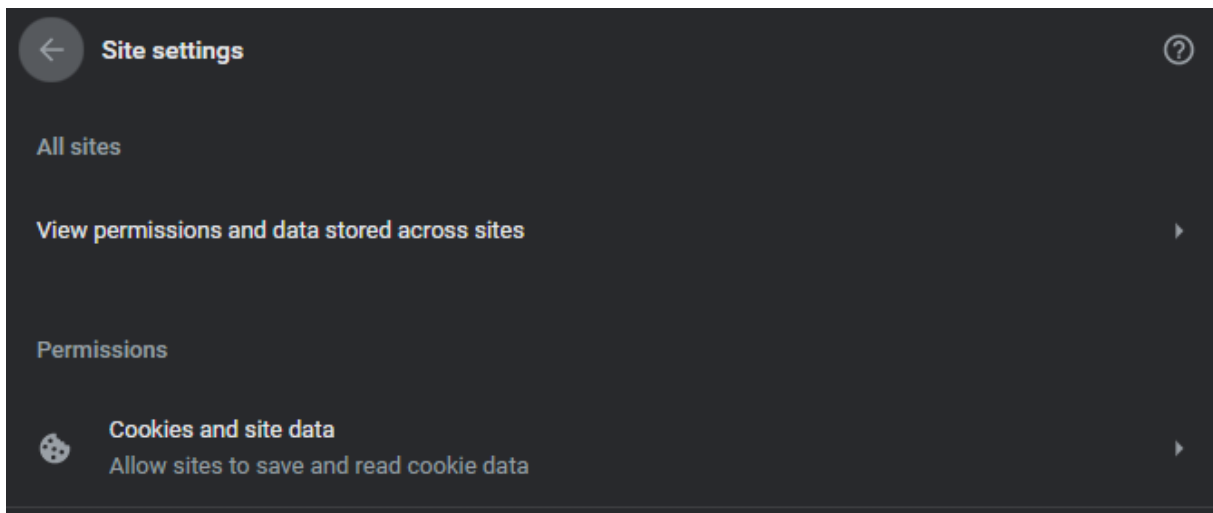
Press the 3-dots in the upper right corner and select 'Settings':



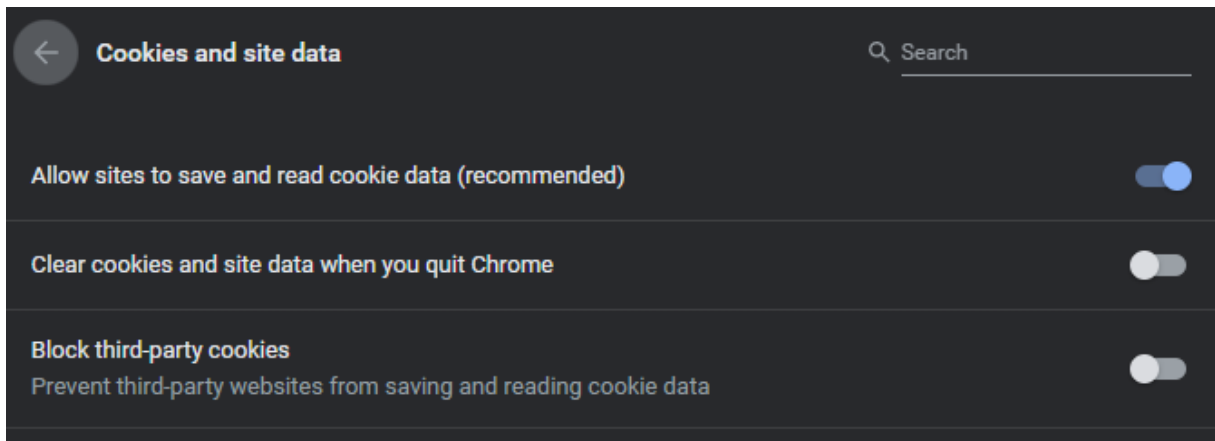
On the left-side select “Privacy & security” and press ‘Site settings’:



Then press ‘Cookies and site data’:

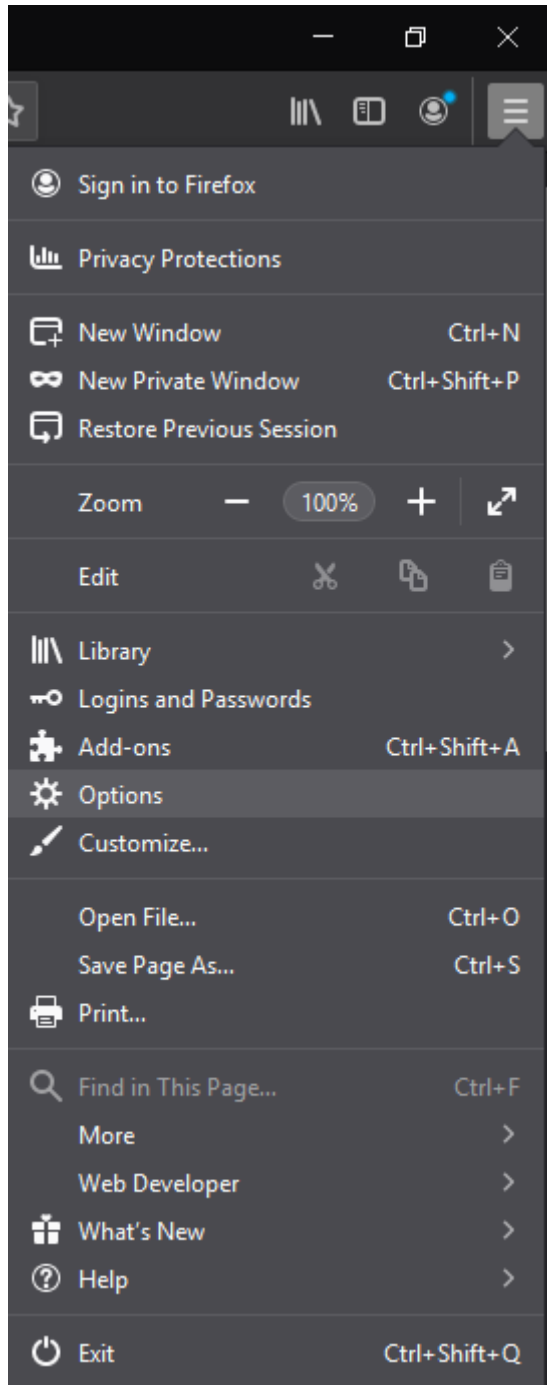


And then enable “Allow sites to save and read cookie data (recommended)” and disable “Block third-party cookies”:

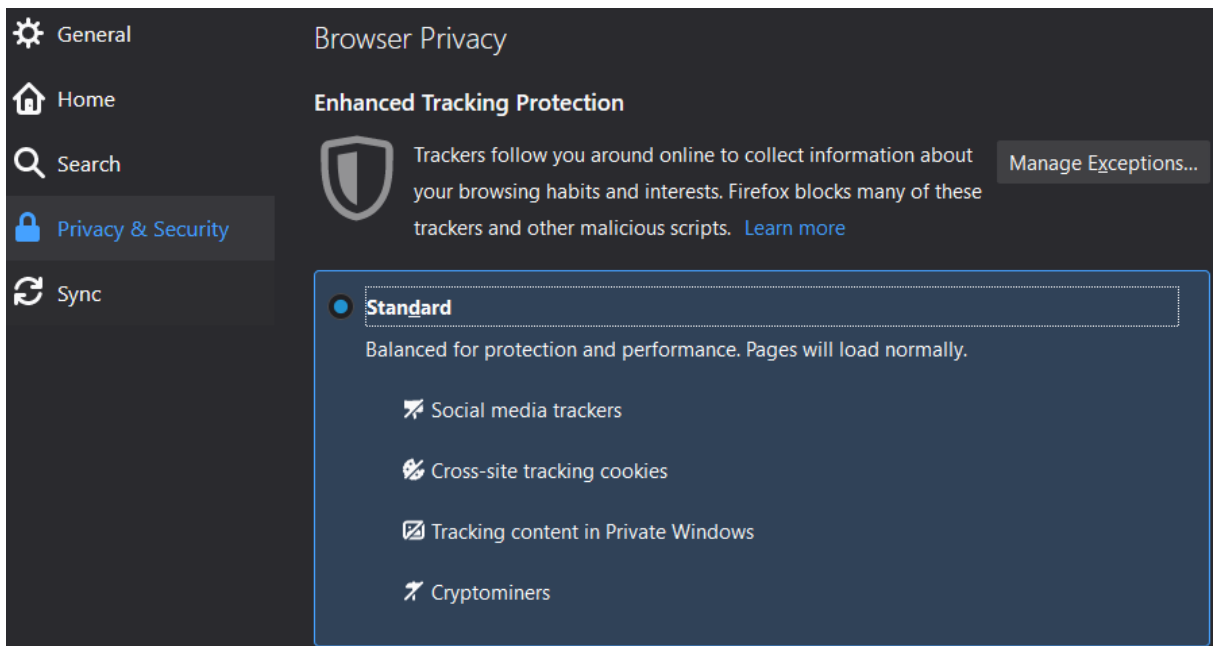


Firefox

Press the 3-dots in the upper right corner and select 'Options':

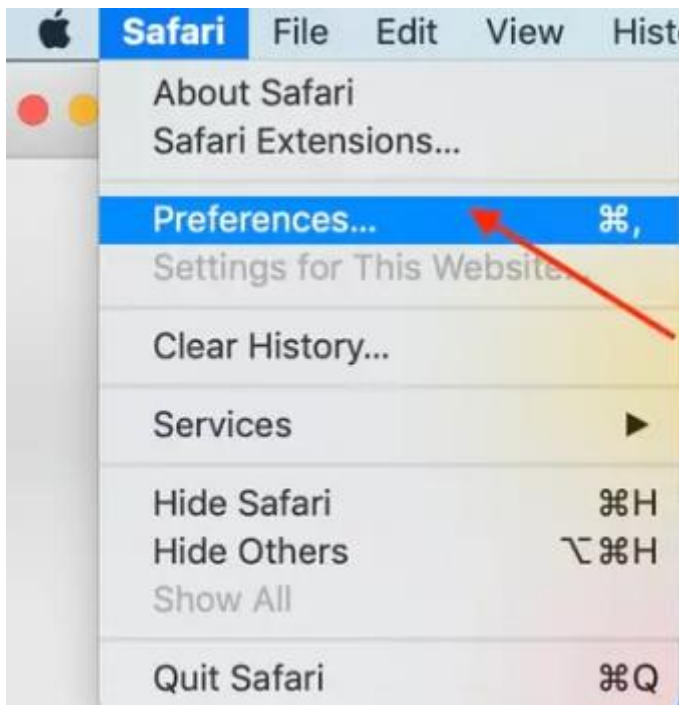


On the left-side select “Privacy & security” and press ‘Standard:
